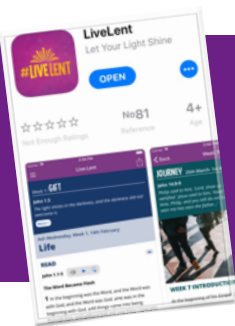
And we've got a range of resources to help you get ready.

Use a copy of the book of daily reflections to reflect with John's gospel each day of Lent. Available for £2 from church.



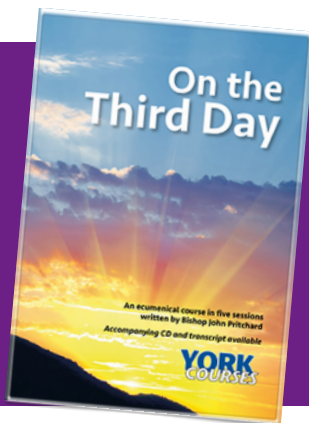
